**ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER
AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On October 12, 2017, Hoehn Oil LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Bartlesville formation at the Gillespie Lease, Johnson County, Kansas.¹
2. On October 16, 2017, Susan Royd-Sykes filed a letter of protest.
3. On October 23, 2017, Alicia Briseno, Cindy Hoedel, Julie Steinbach, Debra Jongenelen, Donnabeth Brown, Julie Steinbach filed letters of protest.
4. On October 27, 2017, David W. Crawford filed a letter of protest.
5. On October 31, Jessica Skyfield filed a letter of protest.
6. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-516-517.² The Commission also finds that a prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.* Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

E. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³
