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

1. All requested changes in injection authority must be submitted with this form.
2. Complete the top portion, (side 1) of the form with the information requested for the pilot well, as shown on the original order or permit.
3. Complete the current operator information, listing the license number, current name and address, contact person and phone number.
4. Fill in the type of change or amendment desired. Leave blank any sections not applicable.
5. For amendments adding additional input wells to enhanced recovery permits, the following information must be submitted in addition to pages 1 and 2 of form U-8:
 - a) pages 1 and 2 of form U-1
 - b) an updated map, showing the new well(s) and all existing wells; page 4 of the form U-1.
 - c) a complete log of the well(s) to be added;
 - d) verification of cement (cement tickets, bond log, etc.)
6. Attach Affidavit of Notice Served, page 5 of form U-1.
7. Attach Affidavit of Publication from the official county newspaper.
8. This form must be signed by the applicant or an authorized agent. A notarization of the signature is required
9. All applicable fees must accompany this application.



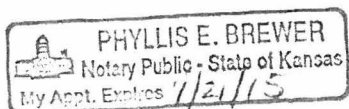

Grand Mesa Operating Company, License #9855- Application to Amend Injection Permit for the Vesecky #1-9I well located in Douglas County, Kansas by adding the following re-pressuring wells to this Application and to authorize the injection of produced and supply well water into the Squirrel Sand zones on each well.

All Oil & Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners and all persons whomever concerned.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that Grand Mesa Operating Company - has filed an application to amend the original application for the Vesecky #1-9I to commence the input of produced and supply well water into the Squirrel Sand formation at the Vesecky #3-7I well, located 914 feet from the north section line and 1914 feet from the west section line; Vesecky #1-6I (TBD) well, located 42 feet from the north section line and 1523 feet from the west section line; Vesecky #3-4I (TBD) well, located 715 feet from the north section line and 990 feet from the west section line; all located in Section 23, Township 14 South, Range 20 East, Douglas County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 525 psi and a

maximum injection rate of 100 barrels per day.

Any persons who object to or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protests with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why this application should not be granted. If no protests are received, this application may be granted through a summary proceeding. If valid protests are received, this matter will be set for hearing.
