## APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND AUTHORITY TO TRANSACT THE BUSINESS OF AN ELECTRIC PUBLIC UTILITY

COMES NOW Evergy Kansas Central Inc. d/b/a Evergy Kansas Central ("Evergy Kansas Central"), and in support of its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Authority, states:

1. Evergy Kansas Central is a Kansas corporation authorized by the Commission to conduct the business of a public utility under the provisions of K.S.A. 66-104, and as such holds a Certificate of Convenience and Authority from this Commission to engage in the business of an electric public utility in the State of Kansas, thereby promoting the public convenience. Evergy Kansas Central seeks to serve, subject to the Commission's approval, in Twin Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Twin Valley") certified territory described below:

## LABETTE COUNTY, KANSAS

A tract of land that is located in the Southeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 20, Township 33 South, and Range 21 East of Labette County, Kansas. See Exhibit A.

- 2. Evergy Kansas Central's certified territory is adjacent to the territory described in paragraph 1.
- 3. Evergy Kansas Central currently serves a police station adjacent to this tract of land. Evergy is applying to serve the above tract of land that is also a part of the police station property

but is reflected in Twin Valley territory. It would be more feasible for the customer for Evergy

Kansas Central to serve the home.

4. Evergy Kansas Central and Twin Valley have mutually agreed, subject to the

Commission's approval, that Evergy Kansas Central should serve as an electric public utility in

the territory described in paragraph 1.


