STAFF'S RESPONSE TO KANSAS GAS SERVICE'S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff and Commission, respectively), by and through counsel, Phoenix Z. Anshutz, hereby files its Response to Kanas Gas Service's (KGS) Motion to Supplement its Response to Staff's Report and Recommendation. Staff states as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. On June 2, 2016, a natural gas fire occurred in an open trench during a construction operation at 918 West 5th Street, Newton, Kansas. The fire injured a contract employee of KGS who was working on the piping at that time. The injury suffered by the contract employee required hospitalization.
- 2. On November 9, 2017, Staff filed its Report and Recommendation which asserted that actions not taken by KGS employees leading up to the natural gas incident resulted in violations of Kansas Pipeline Safety Regulations.
- 3. On January 19, 2018, KGS filed its Response to Staff's Report and Recommendation. The Response included documentation of KGS' corrective efforts attached to the filing as "Attachment A". Attachment A contained two documents labeled "Phase I" and "Phase II". At the time of the filing, the tasks referenced in Phase I had been completed. However, the tasks referenced in Phase II had not yet been completed.

4. Since the filing of KGS' initial response, the tasks set forth in Phase II have been completed.

5. On May 1, 2018, KGS filed a *Motion to Supplement its [KGS] Response to Staff's Report and Recommendation*. In the Motion, KGS states that "because the corrective efforts documented in the proposed supplemental document evidence the Company's focus on safety and its efforts to address Staff's concerns, the Company now seeks to supplement its Response to Staff's Report and Recommendation with the document attached hereto as "Attachment A- Phase II – Updated".

II. DISCUSSION

7. Staff has reviewed the Motion of Kansas Gas Service and believes good cause exists to grant the same. The attachment to the Motion adds clarity and extensiveness to the record.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the Commission accept Kansas Gas Service's Motion to Supplement.
