WELL PLUGGING NOTICE

The State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") has determined by its Order dated May 23, 2013, in the captioned docket that, the wells on the captioned property are abandoned within the meaning of K.S.A. 55-179. The Commission ordered that those abandoned wells be plugged from the Commission well plugging assurance fund or the abandoned oil and gas well fund, as appropriate.

In addition the Commission claims a lien pursuant to K.S.A. 55-180 on any equipment located on the property and on any interest in and to the oil and gas rights of any person found to be responsible for plugging these abandoned wells at a later date.

The Commission will commence plugging these abandoned wells unless an objection to the Commission's Order is filed within 15 days after publication of this Notice.
