ORDER GRANTING THE KANSAS MUNICIPAL ENERGY AGENCY'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission finds and concludes:

- 1. On September 17, 2025, Southern Pioneer Electric Company ("Southern Pioneer") filed with the Commission an application requesting approval of the continuation of its Formula-Based Rate Plan.¹
- 2. On September 26, 2025, the Kansas Municipal Energy Agency ("KMEA") filed a Petition to Intervene, citing its purpose and statutory authority to represent its 88 member cities across the State.²
- 3. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in the interest of justice, if the intervention allows for the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings to continue unimpaired, and if the party seeking intervention has factually demonstrated that its legal rights, duties and privileges, immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.³

4. Certain KMEA member cities take utility service under Southern Pioneer's Local

Access Delivery Service ("LADS") tariff, which is subject to the previously approved 34.5kV

formula-based rate plan (34.5kV FBR Plan).⁴ KMEA participated in Southern Pioneer's previous

annual 34.5kV FBR dockets and seeks to continue to protect the interests of its member cities.⁵

KMEA's member cities will or may be bound by any Commission order or activity in this

proceeding. 6 KMEA has a substantial and vital interest in the outcome of this proceeding, which

cannot be adequately represented by any other party.7

5. KMEA's intervention is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly

and prompt conduct of the proceedings.8

6. The Commission finds KMEA has demonstrated an interest in this proceeding and

meets the above requirements to intervene in this proceeding. Therefore, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-

521 the Commission grants KMEA's Petition for Intervention.
