PRE-FILED REBUTTAL TESTIMONY OF LEE B, SHOBE ON BEHALF OF QUAIL OIL & GAS, LC

1 Q. Please state your name, position, employer and office address. My name is Lee B. Shobe. I am an independent geologist. My address is 9232 W. Brandt A. 2 Avenue, Littleton, Colorado 80123. 3 Do you have any specific response to Dr. James Abers' pre-filed testimony? 4 Q. 5 A. Yes, while the US Geological Survey has concluded that wastewater disposal is a source of the recent increase in earthquakes in the central United States (USGS, Induced Earthquakes 6 Myths and Misconceptions, 2017), the US Geological Survey in the same paper has also 7 concluded that "[n]ot all wastewater injection wells induce earthquakes." In fact: 8 Most injection wells are not associated with felt earthquakes. A combination of 9 10 many factors is necessary for injection to induce felt earthquakes. These include: the injection rate and total volume injected; the presence of faults that are large 11 enough to produce felt earthquakes; stresses that are large enough to produce 12 earthquakes; and the presence of pathways for the fluid pressure to travel from the 13 injection point to faults. 14

- 6 A. Yes, I searched the NEIC website on April 13, 2017 and again on May 24, 2017.
- 7 Q. As of May 24, 2017, did such NEIC website show any earthquakes since 1950 with an
- 8 epicenter in Morris County, Kansas?
- 9 A. No.
- 10 Q. Are you familiar with the history of injection wells in Morris County, Kansas?
- 11 A. Yes.
- 12 Q. To your knowledge, when were injection wells first used in Morris County, Kansas?
- 13 A. Injection wells have been used in such Area since the 1920's.
- 14 Q. Does this conclude your rebuttal testimony?
- 15. A. Yes.
