**ORDER TO LIFT STAY**

The Staff's Motion to Lift Stay filed on May 11, 2012, comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration. The Commission, being duly advised in the premises, and after having examined its files and records, finds and concludes as follows:

1.      On May 4, 2011, the Kansas Highway Patrol issued a Notice of Violation against EEI, LLC (Respondent) for alleged violations found during an April 27, 2011, routine motor carrier stop and inspection conducted by the Kansas Highway Patrol.
2.      On July 11, 2011, Respondent's counsel, Jason P. Hoffman of Hoffman & Hoffman, filed a Request for Hearing on behalf of Respondent.
3.      On July 12, 2011, Commission Staff (Staff) issued a Notice of Hearing which set the matter for hearing by the Commission on August 11, 2011, at 11:30 a.m., and established deadlines for prefiled testimony.

4. On September 15, 2011, Staff filed a Second Motion to Continue and on November 23, 2011, the Commission entered an order continuing the hearing to February 2012.

5. On December 30, 2011, Staff filed a Third Motion to Continue and on January 6, 2012, the Commission entered an order continuing the hearing to April 12, 2012.

6. On March 21, 2012, Staff filed a Motion for Stay stating additional time is necessary to allow the criminal case against Respondent sufficient time to be decided. (District Court of Wabaunsee County, Kansas, Case No. 2011 CR 103.)

7. On March 28, 2012, the Commission issued an order approving Staff's Motion for Stay.

8. On May 11, 2012, staff filed a Motion to Lift Stay, stating that the criminal case has been concluded. Staff's recommendation to the Commission to lift the stay is reasonable and is hereby approved.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. Staff's Motion to Lift Stay is granted and this docket shall be open for further proceedings.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 66-118b; K.S.A. 77-529.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
