ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On November 1, 2016, the Commission issued a *Penalty Order* in this docket to One Source Financial Services, Inc. (Operator), finding that Operator committed seven violations of K.A.R. 82-3-111.¹
2. On December 5, 2016, Operator timely requested a hearing in this matter.
3. On March 7, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*, scheduling an evidentiary hearing in this matter for April 20, 2017.²
4. On March 15, 2017, Operator filed a letter withdrawing its request for a hearing in this matter.
5. Requests for hearing must be filed within 30 days of service of the *Penalty Order* or the *Penalty Order* becomes a final order.³ The Operator in this matter timely filed a hearing request but subsequently withdrew the request. As such, no request for hearing stands, and the *Penalty Order* became effective at the expiration of the 30 days, on or about December 5, 2016.

6. Based on the Penalty Order's effectiveness, the Commission finds no further proceedings are necessary, and the docket shall be closed.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. This docket is closed.


B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.⁴

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
