**SUSPENSION ORDER**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1.        On May 31, 2016, Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC (Mid-America Pipeline) filed an Application for approval of tariff revisions, to become effective July 1, 2016, based on the annual rate indexing methodology authorized by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The Application seeks approval of K.C.C. No. 19.5.0.

2.        Commission Staff (Staff) has determined that it needs more than 30 days to fully review Mid-America Pipeline's Application, and suspension is required to allow sufficient time for Staff's review and investigation in this matter. Staff anticipates it will file its Report and Recommendation (R&R) within sixty (60) days of Mid-America Pipeline's filing of its Application.

3.        The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of the Application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), the Application shall be suspended for a

period of 240 days from the date the Application was made, May 31, 2016, until January 26, 2017.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. Mid-America Pipeline's Application docket shall be suspended and the effective date deferred until January 26, 2017.


B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if served by mail, from the date of service of this Order in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.<sup>1</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders, as necessary.
