I hereby request a hearing concerning the penalty order.

I was unable to function or transact business, starting in March 2017.

I did not pump or operate any leases during 2017.

I have eleven (11) wells on my well inventory. At present, I am in serious Negotiations on six of these wells to sell and transfer. The remaining five (5) Wells are for sale, but no serious buyers at this time.

Health problems have been a major problem starting in March 2017.

During March I became ill and Doctor thought I was having stomach flu. Two days later my Gall Bladder ruptured and filled my stomach and intestines with Infection. This was nearly fatal, which caused a slow recovery.

During August I was at Ulysses Kansas at the county facility, and took a hard fall. My major injury was bone fracture of my nasal cavity and upper left eye socket, with Server brain concussion, this concussion caused blackouts and dizzy spells.

I had a blackout on September 27, while driving to Greenwood County, Kansas to plug A well. I was injured in the car wreck and had more problems getting my mind to work and Remember facts.

John Elmore, Plugging and Commissioner Rep. Mike Hefferny plugged the well without my

presents. My Thanks and gratitude to both of them.

Sometime during the summer I suffer a stroke, but treated it as after effects of the concussion. This has caused me to be unable to function normally, physically and mentally. I have been falling down numerous times and suffered broken ribs on two occasions.

Recovery has been slow, but I have days when I can function for three or four hours.

I have renewed my operator's licenses.

I have respectively believed that a penalty assessment due to my inactions is overly Severe. My health problems were not self-induced.

I am looking forward to the hearing, when I can answer questions and clarify.
