PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On February 26, 2019, the Commission issued penalty orders against Quito, Inc. (Operator) in these dockets, finding a total of three violations of K.A.R. 82-3-111. On March 20, 2019, Operator filed a request for hearing in both dockets. On April 2, 2019, the Commission issued an order joining the dockets and setting an April 23, 2019, prehearing conference.
- 2. At the April 23, 2019, prehearing conference, all parties consented to the electronic service of all documents⁴ and orders.⁵ Therefore, the Prehearing Officer directs that service of all documents and orders may be made by email. To the extent that it is practicable, any electronically served document or order shall be attached to the email and served in pdf format. Service of orders is
