## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO THE CITIZENS' UTILITY RATEPAYER BOARD

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) upon the Petition of the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) to intervene in the above captioned matter. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On January 9, 2014, Atmos Energy filed an application with the Commission for Adjustment of its Natural Gas Rates in the State of Kansas.

2. On January 10, 2014, CURB filed a Petition to Intervene and Motion for Protective Order.<sup>1</sup> In its Petition, CURB stated that it is composed of five volunteer consumer advocate members statutorily authorized to represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in any utility proceeding before the Commission under K.S.A. 66-1223, *et seq.*<sup>2</sup> CURB requests permission to intervene as the rates paid by those customers will or may be affected by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding.<sup>3</sup>

3. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties and privileges,

immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.<sup>4</sup> Furthermore, at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may impose limitations on an intervenor's participation.<sup>5</sup>

4. The Commission finds and concludes that CURB has met the requirements of K.A.R. 82-1-225 and K.S.A. 77-521 and should be granted intervention in this Docket. CURB will be added to the mailing list, service of pleadings, communications, and correspondence should be delivered to counsel of record, as follows:
