ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On October 24, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference*, setting a November 14, 2017, Prehearing Conference, which was subsequently continued to January 16, 2018, via a Prehearing Officer Order.²
- 2. On December 7, 2017, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Close Docket, wherein Staff stated its determination "that the [persons comprising the general partnership] do not have the funds to plug any wells, are unlikely to ever obtain such funds, and that further prosecution of this matter would not be a prudent use of state resources."
- 3. The Commission accepts Staff's conclusion that all remaining issues regarding the well currently on Operator's license can be handled administratively, without further formal proceedings, and therefore finds this docket should be closed.⁴
