
**MID-AMERICA PIPELINE COMPANY'S MOTION TO WAIVE THE 30-DAY NOTICE
REQUIREMENT OF KAR 82-1-214 TO THE EXTENT SUCH WAIVER MAY BE
DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE COMMISSION**

Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC ("MAPL") filed an application with the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission" or "KCC") on July 25, 2011 for the purpose of establishing rates for transportation service in accordance with K.S.A. 66-117, K.S.A. 66-1,217 and K.A.R. 82-10-2. In the application, MAPL included a Motion requesting that the Commission temporarily waive the requirement under KAR 82-10-2 that testimony be filed simultaneously with the application, asking that MAPL be allowed to file such testimony on August 19, 2011. In the application, MAPL confirmed that the time deadlines contained in K.S.A. 66-117 would not begin running until the testimony is filed on August 19, 2011.

2. Pursuant to KAR 82-1-214, MAPL gave the Commission notice on July 20, 2011, of its intent to commence a rate proceeding. In the Notice Letter, MAPL explained that it would file the application on or about July 25, 2011, but that the application would request a waiver of the testimony filing requirements until August 19, 2011. As such, the Notice Letter stated that the application would not be considered fully submitted by MAPL until August 19, 2011 – a full thirty days after the Notice Letter was served.

3. Staff has requested that MAPL file this Motion requesting a waiver of the 30-day notice requirement of KAR 82-1-214 to the extent the Commission believes such waiver to be necessary. MAPL does not believe a waiver is required since the rate proceeding will not have commenced prior to thirty days after Notice was given. However, MAPL has no objection to making this filing to comply with Staff's request and to allow the Commission to address the issue, if the Commission deems it necessary.


