**APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF THE FCC MODERNIZING
 UNBUNDLING AND RESALE REQUIREMENTS AMENDMENT**

COME NOW, Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink, United Telephone Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink, and United Telephone Company of Eastern Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink (hereinafter connectively “CenturyLink”) and file this Application for Approval of the FCC Modernizing Unbundling and Resale Requirements Amendment (“Amendment”) between CenturyLink and Comcast Phone of Kansas, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone (“CLEC”) pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (“the Act”). In support of its Application, CenturyLink states the following:

I. AMENDMENT

CenturyLink presents to the Commission the Amendment for approval pursuant to the terms of the Act. The implementation of the Amendment complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Act because the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Amendment promotes

diversity in providers and increases customer choice for telecommunications services. The negotiated and executed Amendment is also consistent with Kansas regulatory statutes.

CenturyLink and Comcast entered into the Interconnection Agreement which was approved by the Commission in Docket No. 17-UTDT-077-IAT on November 1, 2016.

I. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

CenturyLink seeks the Commission's approval of the Amendment, consistent with the provisions of the Act. The Amendment is bilateral, reached as a result of negotiation and compromise between the parties. There are no outstanding issues involving the limited subject matter of the Amendment that require the assistance of mediation or arbitration. CenturyLink and CLEC do not believe a docket or intervention by other parties is necessary or appropriate.

CenturyLink requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of the Amendment, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation.

II. STANDARD OF REVIEW

The statutory standard of review under Section 252(e) of the Act states:

(e) Approval by State Commission.

(1) Approval Required. – Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement with written findings as to any deficiencies.

(2) Grounds For Rejection – The State commission may only reject –

(A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that –

(i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or

(ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

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



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

**FCC Modernizing Unbundling and Resale Requirements Amendment

and
Comcast Phone of Kansas, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone
for the State of Kansas**

This is an Amendment ("Amendment") to the Interconnection Agreement between Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, United Telephone Company of Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink, United Telephone Company of Southcentral Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink, United Telephone Company of Eastern Kansas d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink"), a Colorado corporation, and Comcast Phone of Kansas, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone ("Comcast"). CenturyLink and Comcast shall be known jointly as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") for service in the state of Kansas which was executed on August 16, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2020, the FCC released Order FCC 20-152, a Report and Order in WC Docket 19-308 for the Modernizing Unbundling and Resale Requirements in an Era of Next-Generation Networks and Services ("Order"), which became effective February 8, 2021 ("Effective Date of the Order"); and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the terms of the Order and consistent with the terms of the Agreement regarding changes in Applicable Law, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement further under the terms and conditions contained herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

Amendment Terms

The Agreement is hereby amended by adding terms and conditions to the Agreement for Unbundled Network Elements (UNEs) as set forth in Attachment 1 and Table 1 to this Amendment, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Any capitalized terms not defined specifically in this Amendment are as defined in the Agreement.

Effective Date

This Amendment shall be deemed effective upon approval by the Commission, or by being permitted to go into effect by operation of law; however, the Parties may agree to implement the provisions of this Amendment upon execution.

Further Amendments

Except as modified herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. The provisions of this Amendment, including the provisions of this sentence, may not be amended, modified or supplemented, and waivers or consents to departures from the provisions of this Amendment may not be given without the written consent thereto by both Parties' authorized representative. No waiver by any Party of any default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder, whether intentional or not, will be deemed to extend to any prior or subsequent default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder or affect in any way any rights arising by virtue of any prior or subsequent such occurrence.

Entire Agreement

The Agreement as amended (including the documents referred to herein) constitutes the full and entire understanding and agreement between the Parties with regard to the subjects of the Agreement as amended and supersedes any prior understandings, agreements, or representations by or between the Parties, written or oral, to the extent they relate in any way to the subjects of the Agreement as amended.

The Parties intending to be legally bound have executed this Amendment as of the dates set forth below, in multiple counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

ATTACHMENT 1

1. UNE Loops

- a. UNE DS1 and DS3 Loops. CenturyLink is no longer required to offer UNE DS1 and DS3 loops in counties deemed competitive in the *BDS Order* (Order FCC 19-66, a Report and Order on Remand and Memorandum Opinion and Order in WC Docket Nos. 18-141, et al (the “UNE Transport Order”), corresponding to the associated Serving Wire Centers listed on the Wholesale website: <http://www.centurylink.com/wholesale/clecs/nta.html>, subject to the following transition periods during which CenturyLink will maintain the embedded base of UNE DS1 and DS3 loops and offer new UNE DS1 loops:

i. UNE DS1

1. Comcast may submit new UNE DS1 orders through February 7, 2023 (“24-month new ordering period”).
2. Comcast may retain its embedded base of UNE DS1 loops (including those ordered in the 24-month new ordering period) in these wire centers at TELRIC rates for 42 months from the Effective Date of the Order. After August 8, 2024, Comcast’s embedded base of UNE DS1 loops in these wire centers will be transitioned to market rates or offered under the applicable state tariff.

ii. UNE DS3

1. Comcast may not submit new orders for UNE DS3 loops in these wire centers after February 8, 2021.
2. Comcast may retain its embedded base of UNE DS3 loops at TELRIC rates in these wire centers for 36 months from the Effective Date of the Order. On Feb 8, 2024, Comcast’s embedded base of UNE DS3 loops in these wire centers will be transitioned to market rates or offered under the applicable state tariff.

- b. UNE DS0 Loops and Associated Copper Subloops. CenturyLink is no longer required to offer these UNEs in “urbanized area census blocks” (census blocks in areas with 50,000 or more people), corresponding to the associated Serving Wire Centers listed on the Wholesale website: <http://www.centurylink.com/wholesale/clecs/nta.html>, subject to the following transition periods during which CenturyLink will maintain the embedded base of these UNEs and offer new UNE DS0 loops:

i. UNE DS0 Loops

1. Comcast may submit new orders for UNE DS0 loops in these wire centers through Feb 7, 2023 (“24-month new order period”).
2. Comcast will retain current pricing for UNE DS0 loops and copper subloops in these wire centers until Feb 8, 2024 (including those ordered in the 24-month new order period). After Feb 8, 2024,

CenturyLink may impose a 25% rate increase for any remaining UNE DS0 loops and copper subloops in these wire centers.

3. Comcast may retain its embedded base of these UNEs (including those ordered in the 24-month new order period) in these wire centers until February 8, 2025. After this date, CenturyLink will be entitled to charge market rates for these UNEs.
4. This transition applies to digital copper loops and two-wire and four-wire copper loops conditioned to transmit digital signals.
- c. Miscellaneous UNE Narrowband Voice-Grade Loops. CenturyLink is no longer required to offer miscellaneous UNE voice-grade loops anywhere, subject to the following transition periods during which CenturyLink will maintain the embedded base of these UNEs:
 - i. Comcast may not submit new orders for miscellaneous UNE voice-grade loops after February 8, 2021.
 - ii. Comcast may retain its embedded base of miscellaneous UNE voice-grade loops until Feb 8, 2024.
 - iii. "Miscellaneous UNE Narrowband Voice-Grade Loops" refer to 64 kbps voice grade channels over fiber loops where CenturyLink has retired copper (which are currently grandfathered) and to the TDM capabilities of hybrid loops.
2. MTE Premises UNE Subloops and NIDs. CenturyLink is not required to offer these UNEs anywhere, subject to the following transition periods during which CenturyLink will maintain the embedded base of these UNEs:
 - a. New Orders. Comcast may not submit new orders for these UNEs after February 7, 2021.
 - b. Embedded Base. Comcast may retain its embedded base of these UNEs until February 8, 2024. After this date, CenturyLink will be entitled to charge market rates for these UNEs.
 - c. This applies to all NIDs and loop plants between the minimum point of entry at a multiunit premise and the point of demarcation.
3. UNE Dark Fiber Transport. CenturyLink is no longer required to offer UNE Dark Fiber transport on routes where the central office on each end of the route is either a Tier 1 or 2 wire center or within half mile of competitive fiber, subject to the following transition periods during which CenturyLink will maintain the embedded base of UNE Dark Fiber Transport without change in rates, terms or conditions:
 - a. After February 8, 2021, Comcast may not submit new orders for UNE Dark Fiber Transport on these routes.
 - b. Comcast may retain its embedded base of UNE Dark Fiber Transport on these routes until February 8, 2029. After this date, CenturyLink will be entitled to charge market rates.
 - c. The central offices meeting the new test (*i.e.*, that are within a half mile of competitive fiber) are listed here: <http://www.centurylink.com/wholesale/clecs/nta.html>.

4. Operations Support Systems (OSS). CenturyLink is no longer required to offer OSS as an independent UNE nationwide, except where necessary to manage other UNEs, for interconnection, or for the local number port orders, subject to the transition periods that apply to the corresponding UNEs.
