# BEFORE THE KANSAS CORPORATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF KANSAS 

In the Matter of the Application for ) Kansas City Power \& Light Company to ) Docket No. 17-KCPE-201-RTS Make Certain Changes in Its Charges for Electric Service.

## JOINT MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Staff), Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCP\&L), and the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB)(collectively, the Joint Movants), hereby move the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for an Order establishing a procedural schedule in the abovecaptioned matter. In support of this Joint Motion, the Joint Movants state the following:

1. On November 9, 2016, Kansas City Power and Light Company filed with the Commission an Application requesting authorization to make certain changes in its charges for electric service in Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117.
2. Subsequent to the filing of KCP\&L's Application, the Joint Movants informally discussed the need for a procedural schedule to guide the remainder of this proceeding. The Joint Movants agree a procedural schedule provides necessary structure and ensures the Commission receives evidence in a timely fashion, while affording due process rights to all interested parties.
3. In developing the proposed schedule below, the Joint Movants took into consideration the Commission's current schedule of availability and potential scheduling conflicts posed by other Commission proceedings. The proposed procedural schedule agreed to by Joint Movants is as follows:

4. The Commission has discretion over whether to hold a public hearing in rate proceedings. ${ }^{1}$ Consistent with the procedure approved in KCP\&L's previous abbreviated rate case, ${ }^{2}$ the Joint Movants agree a public hearing is unnecessary in this docket. As in the previous abbreviated rate case, the vast majority of revenue requirement components in this case are updates or true-ups to costs which have already been approved for recovery in prior dockets. ${ }^{3}$ Also, pursuant to Commission regulations, KCP\&L is adopting all of the regulatory procedures, principles, and rate of return established in its most recent general rate proceeding, Docket No. 15-KCPE-116-RTS. ${ }^{4}$
5. The Joint Movants further recommend that the Commission direct KCP\&L to provide notice of its Application and the evidentiary hearing by including a bill insert with the monthly billing statement for each customer in KCP\&L's service territory. The bill inserts will comply with the Commission's regulations and explain the opportunity for the public to submit comments regarding KCP\&L's Application. KCP\&L will consult with the Commission's Director of Public Affairs and Consumer Protection and submit the notice to the Prehearing Officer for approval. This recommendation is also consistent with the procedure in KCP\&L's previous abbreviated rate case. ${ }^{5}$

WHEREFORE, Joint Movants respectfully request the Commission issue an order granting this Joint Motion and approving the procedural schedule and customer notice recommendations set forth above.
