STAFF'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

Litigation Counsel for Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Litigation Counsel, Staff and Commission, respectively) presents the above-captioned matter and motion to the Commission to continue the hearing currently scheduled in the above-referenced docket on January 14, 2015, at 9:30 a.m., and extend the deadlines for filing of direct testimony. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- On or about July 7, 2014, the Kansas Highway Patrol (KHP) issued a Notice of Violation assessing fines against BMS Transportation Company, Inc. (Respondent), for violations found during a June 23, 2014, routine motor carrier stop and inspection.

- On November 24, 2014, Litigation Counsel for Staff prepared, served on Respondent, and filed with the Commission a Notice of Hearing setting the matter for hearing before the Commission on January 14, 2014, at 9:30 a.m.

tragedy and loss.

5. The continuance requested herein is necessary to allow the KHP witness

some recovery time before having to enter testimony for the above-referenced hearing

scheduled on January 14, 2015. Respondent does not oppose this request for a

continuance.

6. Staff therefore requests that the hearing in this matter be continued until

February 16, 2014; that the filing date for the parties' prefiled direct testimony be

extended to ten days prior to the newly-scheduled hearing date; and that the rebuttal

testimony be presented at the hearing.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Staff respectfully requests that the

Commission grant this Motion for Continuance and that the hearing currently scheduled

be continued until February 16, 2014.; that the filing date for the parties' prefiled direct

testimony be extended to ten days prior to the newly-scheduled hearing date; and that any

rebuttal testimony of the parties be presented at the hearing.
