converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as

provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).³ Any party that fails to attend or

participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held

in default pursuant to the KAPA.⁴

A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁵ D.

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition

for reconsideration.⁶
