ORDER ADOPTING STAFF'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) on the Application of Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) for approval of its updated Transmission Delivery Charge (TDC) tariff. After review of the pleadings, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions.

- 1. On November 15, 2017, KCPL filed its Application requesting approval of its updated TDC tariff.¹
- 2. On December 5, 2017, the Commission granted intervention to the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB).²
- 3. On December 19, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Acknowledging Effective Date of Transmission Delivery Charge Subject-to-Refund, Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-1237.³
- 4. On April 3, 2017, after examining KCPL's Application, Staff filed its Report and Recommendation, which recommended the Commission continue to allow KCPL's TDC rate

schedules reflecting the removal of the correction for the previous transposition error to be collected.⁵

 The Commission has reviewed Staff's Report and Recommendation and finds it is just and reasonable to allow KCPL to continue to collect its updated TDC as described in its Application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- (A) The Commission hereby adopts Staff's Report and Recommendation, filed in this docket on April 3, 2018, and hereby orders Kansas City Power and Light Company to continue its TDC rate schedules reflecting the removal of the correction for the previous transposition error to be collected.
- (B) The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).
- (C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
