ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On June 14, 2011, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas

(AT&T Kansas) filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement between

AT&T Kansas and WiMacTel, Inc. (WiMacTel).

2. On August 31, 2011, Commission staff (Staff) filed a report recommending the Commission approve the agreement. Staff stated that WiMacTel is certificated in Kansas as both a competitive local exchange carrier and an interexchange carrier, and stated that WiMacTel is a diverse company specializing in public communications and operator services throughout Canada, the United States, Latin America, and the Caribbean. Staff stated that WiMacTel is properly registered to do business in Kansas, and recommended the Commission grant approval of the interconnection agreement, in that Section 252(e) of the Federal Act provides that state commissions may reject a negotiated agreement only if it finds that the agreement, or portions of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or

that the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Staff states that it has reviewed the agreement and finds no such cause for concern.

3. The Commission finds Staff's recommendation to approve the agreement to be appropriate.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The application of SWBT for approval of its interconnection agreement with WiMacTel is granted and the agreement is approved, as filed.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
