## MOTION TO APPROVE APPLICATION FOR LICENSE AND TO CANCEL OR CONTINUE PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively) files this Motion, asking that the Commission's license denial order be rescinded, that Staff be directed to approve Applicant's license, and that the prehearing conference be cancelled or at least continued. In support of its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On August 29, 2017, the Commission issued an *Order Denying Application for License* to Black Gold Oil, LLC ("Applicant"), based upon Staff's determination that Applicant was associated with Sage Oil and Gas, an operator out of compliance with K.S.A. Chapter 55.
- 2. On October 10, 2017, the Commission issued an *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, setting an October 26, 2017, prehearing conference.
- 3. Following the receipt and review of additional information, Staff has concluded that Applicant meets the requirements of K.S.A. 55-155 and K.A.R. 82-3-120. <sup>1</sup> Therefore, Staff requests that the Commission rescind its August 29, 2017, *Order Denying Application for License*, and that Staff be directed to approve Applicant's license.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Specifically, the State of Kansas has been reimbursed for its plugging of the Ward #5 well, resulting in Sage Oil and Gas no longer being out of compliance with K.S.A. Chapter 55 and Commission Docket 15-CONS-667-CSHO.

4. Should the Commission rescind its August 29, 2017, Order Denying Application

for License, Staff will approve Applicant's license renewal application, all matters pertaining to

Operator will be resolved, and this docket can be closed.

5. Staff notes that it is unavailable for a prehearing conference on October 26, 2017,

and therefore requests that should the Commission not grant Staff's Motion as it pertains to the

license application prior to that date, that the prehearing conference be continued.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully moves the Commission to rescind its August 29, 2017,

Order Denying Application for License, to direct Staff to approve the application and close this

docket, and for any other determination that the Commission finds proper.


