RESPONSE OF BLACK HILLS/KANSAS GAS UTILITY COMPANY, LLC IN SUPPORT OF RESPONSES OF ATMOS ENERGY AND KANSAS GAS SERVICE

Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills" or "Company") hereby submits this response in support of the recently filed reply comments ("Replies") of Atmos Energy ("Atmos"), and Kansas Gas Service ("KGS") regarding the Kansas Corporation Commission (the "Commission") Staff's Report and Recommendation ("Staff's R&R") and the Citizen Utility Ratepayers Board ("CURB") reply filed in the above-captioned docket. This filing is made in support of the permanent waiver of the "knock and collect" provision of the Commission's *Electric, Natural Gas, and Water Billing Standards* ("Billing Standards") and to address the issues of 1) disconnection and reconnection fees and 2) energy insecurity as discussed in the filings.

I. PERMANENT WAIVER OF THE KNOCK AND COLLECTION PROVISION OF THE BILLING STANDARDS

The Commission Staff, CURB, Atmos, and KGS have each provided comments in support of, or not opposed to, a permanent waiver of the "knock and collect" provision of the Billing Standards. The Commission Staff made an additional recommendation that Black Hills' permanent

waiver be "contingent on the implementation of a customer education campaign and sufficient notification to its customers through bill inserts and website updates".

Black Hills supports the Commission Staff's recommendation that the Commission grant Black Hills a permanent waiver of the knock and collect provision of the Billing Standards, including the customer education program and notification process. Black Hills, pending Commission approval, proposes including education material on this change in Company procedure to its website and providing a link to these materials to customers that receive their bills electronically. For customers that receive physical bills, a bill insert will be sent that contains the same educational material as the electronic version.

II. <u>DISCONNECTION AND RECONNECTION FEES AS A RESULT OF NONPAYMENT</u>

The issue of reinstating disconnection and reconnection fees to their pre-pilot program levels is a contested issue in this proceeding. Staff has recommended reinstating these fees, while CURB has suggested removing disconnection and reconnection fees in cases of non-payment and to socialize the costs of these fees to prevent undue hardship for low-income customers². Both Atmos and KGS support Staff's recommendation to reinstate these fees to their pre-pilot levels and contend that any subsidization of these fees be done in the utilities' next general rate case so that costs are recovered in base rates at the time the fees are eliminated³⁴.

Black Hills agrees with Atmos and KGS that to the extent the Commission agrees with CURB and decides to socialize certain disconnect and reconnection costs, then it should be done in the Company's next general rate case so that these costs are recovered through base rates.

III. <u>ENERGY INSECURITY</u>

CURB's reply to Staff's R&R includes a request to the Commission to "express strong support for study and work conducted by Kansas utilities, Staff, CURB....to reduce energy insecurity in Kansas." As both Atmos and KGS affirmed in their Replies⁵⁶, Black Hills also supports the continued collaboration between Commission Staff, CURB, and other stakeholders to create effective solutions for energy insecurity in Kansas.

CONCLUSION AND REQUEST FOR COMMISSION ACTION

In conclusion, Black Hills Energy respectfully requests that the Commission grant the permanent waiver of the knock and collect provision for Black Hills Energy, as recommended by Staff, and emphasize that any future adjustments to disconnection and reconnection fees be handled exclusively within the rate case process.

Black Hills remains committed to working collaboratively with CURB, Staff, and all stakeholders to address energy insecurity in Kansas and ensure that customers have access to safe, reliable, and affordable natural gas service.

WHEREFORE, Black Hills Energy respectfully requests that the Commission:

Grant a permanent waiver of the knock and collect provision of the Billing
 Standards for Black Hills; and

2. Address any adjustments to disconnection and reconnection fees exclusively within general rate cases as decided by the Commission.
