### ORDER ASSESSING COSTS

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On September 9, 2016, Southern Pioneer Electric Company (Southern Pioneer) filed a Complaint against the Kansas Power Pool (KPP), alleging unnecessary bypass and duplication of electric facilities.
- 2. When the Commission deems it necessary to investigate any public utility or common carrier, and the costs of the investigation exceed \$100.00, the Commission may assess the public utility or common carrier for the costs of the investigation. The Commission finds that the expenses reasonably attributable to this investigation will exceed \$100.
- 3. In this proceeding, an investigation of a dispute between two public utilities, the Commission finds expenses should be assessed jointly and equally against Southern Pioneer and KPP. This order constitutes notice of the assessment of costs, and the assessment will begin three days after the date this order is mailed. Southern Pioneer and KPP are hereby given notice

that they may request a hearing as to the necessity of the investigation or the assessment of costs, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Southern Pioneer and KPP will be assessed jointly and equally for costs associated with this proceeding.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein.<sup>2</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
