This is a notice of a penalty assessment against TM Trucking LLC (TM Trucking) for violations of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted May 17, 2024, by a Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 29, 2023. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

**IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY:** TM Trucking has been assessed a \$350 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$350, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</a>. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of TM Trucking to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website <a href="http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety\_meetings.htm">http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety\_meetings.htm</a>.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. TM Trucking must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/</a>, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.1

<u>IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:</u> Failure to pay the penalty of \$350 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

### PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On May 17, 2024, a Commission Staff ("Staff") Special Investigator ("SI") completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of TM Trucking LLC (TM Trucking or Carrier). TM Trucking is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 2844344.
- 2. On May 20, 2024, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation ("R&R"), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$350 to be issued to TM Trucking based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigation, the SI identified one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) count, of the Motor

Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.<sup>2</sup>

- 3. Additionally, Staff recommends that TM Trucking be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.<sup>3</sup> A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.
- 4. Staff further recommends TM Trucking submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.<sup>4</sup>
- 5. Finally, Staff recommends that TM Trucking submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.<sup>5</sup> Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112 and 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in

Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.

- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.
- 8. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

### IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. TM Trucking is hereby assessed a \$350 civil penalty for one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) count, of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. TM Trucking is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.
- C. TM Trucking is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed

information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

- D. TM Trucking is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.
- E. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/</a>, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of TM Trucking's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.
- F. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest.<sup>6</sup> For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.<sup>7</sup>

G. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$350 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$350 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at <a href="https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/">https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/</a>. You must have an

account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

H. Failure to pay the \$350 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of TM Trucking's motor carrier operating authority without further notice.<sup>8</sup> Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

TM Trucking LLC is a motor carrier (MC) possessing pubic for-hire operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling construction, grain, feed, hay, rock, sand, and asphalt. TM Trucking LLC operates under USDOT 2844344. On May 17, 2024, a Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of TM Trucking LLC. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) specific count, of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$350 be issued to the MC.

### **DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:**

On May 17, 2024, a Commission Staff SI conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of TM Trucking LLC. The investigation covers a 365 day period. Each specific count is detailed below.

### Count One (1 of 1)

<u>Juris diction</u>: 49 C.F.R. 382.701(a), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

<u>Intent of Law</u>: The MC must conduct a pre-employment inquiry into its drivers with the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse.

**Supporting Documentation**: On March 12, 2024, TM Trucking LLC required or permitted its driver, Jesus Aguilar, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 2006 Kenworth N14 Cummins, VIN ending in 3675, GVWR 52,000 lbs., pulling a 2014 Kruz end dump, VIN ending in 6284, GVWR 80,000 lbs., in intrastate commerce within Wichita, Kansas. The trip is evidenced by Jesus Aguilar's Driver's Daily Log, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, a Bill of Lading from Cornejo Quality Store dated March 12, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and TM Trucking LLC's compliance report from the DACH attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**. The DACH report evidences that no pre-employment queries had been conducted as of May 17, 2024.

<u>Violation</u>: TM Trucking LLCC failed to conduct a pre-employment query in the Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse on the driver involved in this transport (Exhibit 1, Page 3). One (1) violation discovered.

**Recommendation**: Staff recommends a fine of \$350.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**


Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find TM Trucking LLC committed one (1) violation, accounting for one (1) specific count, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$350 for one (1) violation of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends TM Trucking LLC require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at <a href="http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety">http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety</a> meetings.htm.

Staff further recommends TM Trucking LLC submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation does not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that TM Trucking LLC submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.




