APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE

Black Hills/Kansas Gas Utility Company, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills"), hereby requests the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") grant it authorization to transact business as a natural gas utility in certain portions of Reno County, Kansas, specifically described as follows:

North Half (N/2) Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

South Half (S/2) Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Northwest Quarter (NW/4) Sections 30 and 32, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Southeast Quarter (SE/4) Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 5 West

Southwest Quarter (SW/4)
Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

All of Sections 24, 25 and 36 Township 23 South, Range 5 West

All of Sections 19, 30 and 31 Township 23 South, Range 4 West

All of Sections 1 and 12 Township 24 South, Range 5 West

All of Sections 6 and 7 Township 24 South, Range 4 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

Maps of the territory for which the Certificate of Convenience and Authority is requested are attached as "Exhibit A".

In support of its Application, Black Hills states:

- 1. Black Hills is a natural gas public utility company under the jurisdiction of the Commission which is engaged in the delivery and sale of natural gas within the meaning of K.S.A. 66-104, in legally designated areas of Kansas. Black Hills holds a certificate of convenience and authority issued by the Commission, authorizing it to engage in such utility business. Black Hills has previously filed with the Commission certified copies of its Articles of Incorporation under which it was organized and a Certificate of Registration as a corporation authorized to do business in Kansas, and all amendments thereto and restatements thereof, and the same are incorporated hereby by reference.
- 2. Black Hills and Midwest Energy have mutually agreed, subject to approval by the Commission, that as a matter of public convenience and to better serve certain natural gas customers, Black Hills should serve as the natural gas public utility in the following described territory:

Northwest Quarter (NW/4) Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

West Half (W/2) Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Southwest Quarter (SW/4) Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

All of Section 12 Township 24 South, Range 5 West

Southeast Quarter (SE/4) Section 1, Township 24 South, Range 5 West

Southeast (SE/4) Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

East Half (E/2) Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 5 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

- 3. The territory described in paragraph 2 is currently within Midwest Energy's service territory. Concurrent with the Application for Certificate, Midwest Energy is filing an Application to cease operations in said territories described in paragraph 2.
- 4. This transfer of territory is pursuant to an agreement between Black Hills and Midwest Energy and will include approximately 18 miles of pipeline. A Memo of Understanding regarding this transfer of territory and assets has been signed and is included as "Exhibit B". The assets would transfer at zero cost to Black Hills. Black Hills would invest approximately \$20,000 on regulating stations at the time of transfer. As part of the proposed transaction, Midwest Energy is transferring 12 customer accounts to Black Hills Energy. A list of those customers is attached to this application as "Exhibit C" and incorporated herein by reference. A letter explaining the proposed transaction and informing the customers of the application filed with the Commission with notice that they can contact Black Hills Energy or the Commission if they have any questions, along with a comparison of Midwest Energy and Black Hills Energy rates, will be mailed to each customer. A sample of that correspondence is attached hereto as "Exhibit D", and incorporated herein by reference.

5. Kansas Gas Service is currently certificated in the following territory that Black Hills is asking for a certificate as part of this application:

All of Sections 24, 25 and 36 Township 23 South, Range 5 West

All of Sections 19, 30 and 31 Township 23 South, Range 4 West

Northwest Quarter (NW/4) Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

West Half (W/2) Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

Southwest Quarter (SW/4) Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 4 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

- 6. Black Hills has conferred with Kansas Gas Service regarding this application and Kansas Gas Service has no objection to Black Hills' request for a certificate. No existing Kansas Gas Service customers are being transferred to Black Hills and Kansas Gas Service is not seeking to cease its certificate in the above-described sections. These sections will remain dually certificated territories.
- 7. Black Hills currently holds certificates of convenience and authority in the following aforementioned areas through Docket 89,418, which allowed Black Hills to serve existing industrial, commercial and wholesale customers:

All of Section 24 Township 23 South, Range 5 West

All of Section 19 Township 23 South, Range 4 West

All in Reno County, Kansas

By this application, Black Hills requests a certificate to serve all classes of customers in said territories.

8. A copy of this application is being served on Midwest Energy and Kansas Gas Service. No other person or entity requires notice of this application.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that a Certificate of Convenience and Authority be issued granting the right to transact the business of a natural gas public utility to Black Hills in the above-described territory.





Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Midwest Energy, Inc.
and
Black Hills Energy
Dated May 8, 2015

Midwest Energy, Inc (Midwest) and Black Hills Energy (Black Hills) agree to cooperate in the following manner to allow Midwest Energy customers to be transferred to Black Hills in the area between Haven and Hutchison, Kansas

- 1. Midwest will seek Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) approval to abandon its certificate to provide natural gas service in the territory associated with said customers. Black Hills will file for a certificate to serve the territory concurrent with Midwest's application to cease certification.
- Subject to KCC approval of the certificate transfer, Midwest will install a new plastic pipeline to serve customers shown on Attachment A. Upon project completion, the pipeline and associated facilities will be owned and operated by Black Hills Black Hills will provide Midwest with all needed line markers to be installed by Midwest. The expected date of completion is July 31, 2015, but meeting this target shall not be a requirement of this agreement.
- 3 Black Hills will install a district regulator station at each of two (2) take off points and install its meters and regulators at each customer's tap on the pipeline referenced in Paragraph 2.
- 4. Midwest will secure all permits and Right Of Way necessary for project completion.
- 5. Midwest will seek KCC approval to abandon its certificate to provide natural gas service in Stevens and Seward Counties. Black Hills will file for a certificate to serve the territory concurrent with Midwest's application to cease certification.
- The foregoing is conditioned upon the receipt of all regulatory approvals and orders regarding this Memorandum including but not limited to state regulatory agencies in a form and manner satisfactory to each party in its sole discretion.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, this Memorandum is not intended by either of the parties to constitute a definitive agreement with respect to the foregoing nor to give rise to any binding obligations between the parties.
