This letter is to inform you that your challenge concerning violation(s) 393.75A3 - Tire-flat and/or audible air leak & 395.8E - False report of drivers record of duty status, has been denied. Please see guidance below

- Tire was measured during inspection as having 0psi, maximum psi tire was listed for is 95psi – per Out of Service Criteria Tires a (7); Tire has noticeable leak or has 50% or less of maximum inflation pressure marked on the tire sidewall. (395.75(a)(3)) – the tire was measured due to present lateral movement.
- False log means inaccurate, does not accurately reflect the driver's actual activities and duty status. At the time of the stop the driver had been logged as off-duty, which reflects inaccurate movement (395.8(e))

The violation(s) will remain on your carrier profile and Invoice #H000579004 remains valid. Please the attached copy of the invoice for information regarding the fines due.
