PREFILED SUPPLEMENTAL TESTIMONY OF BILL JACKSON ON BEHALF OF IGWT, INC.

- 1 Q: Would you please state your name, position, employer, and office address?
- 2 A: My name is Bill Jackson. I am a self-employed petroleum geologist consulting with
- 3 IGWT, Inc. My business office address is 315 Main, El Dorado, Kansas.
- 4 Q: Have you previously pre-filed testimony in this docket
- 5 A: Yes.
- 6 Q: What is the purpose of the testimony you are presenting now?
- 7 A: The prehearing officer's Order of October 25, 2018, in this docket, stated that the Operator,
- 8 which is the applicant IGWT, Inc., was permitted to file supplemental testimony in this
- 9 docket by November 9, 2018. My testimony here is offered for that purpose.
- 10 Q: Have you reviewed the prefiled testimony in this docket of Mr. Jake Eastes of the
- 11 Commission staff?
- 12 A: Yes, I have reviewed Mr. Eastes' testimony.
- 13 Q: Do you have supplemental testimony in response to Mr. Eastes' testimony?

Yes. The October 28, 2018, Order specifically noted that Commission staff had questions 1 A: regarding this application and I can provide answers to those questions, specifically as 2 appears at page 6, line 9-13. First, I offer Jackson Supplemental Exhibit A, which depicts 3 an electric log of the Jones #4 well located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 33, a scout card 4 of the Varner Farms #1 well located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 33, and a strip log of the 5 Gray #1 well located in the N/2 NE/4 of Section 33, and further depicts a cross-section 6 lying across these three wells that shows the Jones well with Mississippi Chert, the Varner 7 well with less Chert, and the Gray well without Chert. The Chert thins from West to East 8 and therefore, as I presented in my original testimony, moving the proposed location to the 9 East will reduce the chances of a successful well. 10
