EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Boomerang Wireless, LLC (Boomerang) filed an Application requesting designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC). Staff requested a dismissal of the Application without prejudice on January 11, 2013. Boomerang has addressed the outstanding issues with Staff, therefore, Staff is withdrawing its prior recommendation that Boomerang's Application be dismissed.

BACKGROUND:

On July 21, 2012, Boomerang filed an Application requesting the Commission grant its request to be designated as an ETC for the purpose of receiving Low-Income Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) support within the state of Kansas. Boomerang's Application indicates it is not seeking to receive high-cost support, only Lifeline support.

On January 11, 2013, Staff filed a recommendation to dismiss Boomerang's request for ETC designation in Kansas. The recommendation to dismiss was due to the poor payment history and the outstanding balance of Boomerang's parent company, HH Ventures, and inadequate responses to Staff's four pending Requests for Information (RFIs).

On January 31, 2013, Boomerang submitted its remaining responses to the four RFIs and provided copies of the electronically submitted updates requested to their Federal filings. As of January 31, 2013, all outstanding KUSF balances and penalty fees have been paid by Boomerang's parent company, HH Ventures. The Company has indicated they have contracted with a third party provider to process their KUSF reports and payments to the KUSF Administrator in the future.

Boomerang has indicated through their legal representation that it is working with Staff and is committed to provide Staff all information and respectfully requests that the Commission not dismiss its Application for designation as an ETC.

ANALYSIS:

Staff has completed its review of Boomerang's newly submitted documentation in response to Staff's recommendation to dismiss the Company's Application. Staff finds the RFI responses provide adequate information in response to the outstanding RFIs. However, Staff reserves the right to submit follow-up RFIs as it deems necessary in its analysis of the Company's Application.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff withdraws its prior recommendation for the dismissal of Boomerang's Application for ETC designation and Staff will continue its analysis to determine if all rules established by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and this Commission are met prior to granting any ETC designation to Boomerang.
