

**MOTION TO CANCEL EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND CLOSE DOCKET**

On June 24, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting that an order to show cause be issued against Operator, based upon Commission records indicating that an unplugged well remained on Operator's expired license. The matter is currently scheduled for a February 20, 2017, evidentiary hearing.

On January 31, 2017, Staff received an acceptable Transfer of Operator ("T-1") Form transferring the well at issue to an active license. As described in Staff's pre-filed testimony, transfer of the well resolves the compliance issue that caused this case to be brought. Since the matter at issue has now been resolved, Staff asks that the evidentiary hearing be cancelled and that the docket be closed.


