## **CERTIFICATE**

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On April 22, 2016, Midwest Energy, Inc. ("Applicant") filed an application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide electric service to a portion of Grant County, Kansas as required by K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131. Applicant is an electric public utility as defined by K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-104. A public hearing was neither requested nor held on this application.
- 2. Specifically, Applicant requests a Certificate in the territory described as follows: GRANT COUNTY

Section 6, Township 28 South, Range 35 West, and Sections 1, 2 and 11, Township 28, Range 36.

3. The territory described in Finding No. 2 above is currently served by Atmos

Energy. Pursuant to Docket No. 16-ATMG-473-CCS, Atmos Energy requests permission to

cease operating as an electric public utility in that territory.

4. Public convenience will be promoted by allowing Applicant to provide electric

service in the territory described in Finding No. 2 above. The application, therefore, should be

granted and a Certificate issued to Applicant in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 2014

Supp. 66-131.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION CONSIDERED AND CERTIFIED:

A. The application filed herein is granted and Midwest Energy, Inc. is permitted to

transact the business of an electric public utility in the territory described in Finding No. 2

herein.

B. A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within fifteen (15)

days from the date of service of this Order. If service is by mail, service is complete upon

mailing, and three (3) days shall be added to the above time frame. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A.

2014 Supp. 77-529.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.

In the Matter of the Application of Atmos Energy to Cease Services as a Natural Gas Public Utility in Section 6, Township 28, Range 35, and Sections 1, 2 and 11, Township 28, Range 36, Grant County, Kansas.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On April 22, 2016, Midwest Energy (Midwest) filed an Application for Certificate in Docket No. 16-MDWG-472-COC and Atmos Energy (Atmos) filed a Companion Cease Service Application in Docket No. 16-ATMG-473-CCS.

## **ANALYSIS:**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-131, the Commission has jurisdiction to grant a certificate to a public utility seeking to transact business in the State of Kansas.

The statutory standard of review in this matter is whether the "public convenience will be promoted by the transaction of said business and permitting said applicants to transact the business of a common carrier or public utility in this state." K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-131.

Atmos is releasing these sections of natural gas territory to Midwest at the request of an irrigation customer. Midwest has closer infrastructure and has agreed to provide natural gas service.

Staff recommends that the Commission find that the public convenience will be promoted by the granting of these Applications.

The Commission action date is October 19, 2016.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff is recommending the Application for Certificate in 16-MWG-472-COC and the Application to Cease Service in 16-ATMG-473-CCS both be granted.
