This information is being provided by the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB") of the State of Kansas to assist you in making an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the proposal of your cooperative's Board of Directors to deregulate your electric cooperative. CURB is the state agency authorized by statute to represent the interests of residential and small business ratepayers in rate proceedings before the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission").

The advantages to deregulation have been highlighted by your electric cooperative. CURB wants you to be aware that there are also disadvantages of deregulation and advantages of continued third party oversight and regulation. One disadvantage of deregulation is the ability of your cooperative to raise your rates at any time without third-party oversight. Advantages of continued third-party oversight and regulation of your electric service and rates by the Commission include:

- The Commission has approved only \$3,781,637 of \$5,087,866 (74.3%) in rate increases approved by the Board of Victory Electric Cooperative for the Mid-Kansas territory served by Victory since 2009. Since these rates were in effect for multi-year periods, the cumulative reduction in rates paid by ratepayers has been much greater.
- Continued service by the Commission's Public Affairs and Consumer Protection Division regarding rate, service, and billing complaints related to your electric service.
- Continued investigation of rate increases requested by your cooperative by the technical Staff
 of the Commission.
