and Docket No. 09-ALCT-478-COC**

Dear Ms. Retz:

ALEC, LLC ("ALEC"), through undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the Commission, pursuant to the Commission's authority from K.S.A 2015 Supp. 66-1, 188 and K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 66-131, cancel ALEC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to provide competitive local exchange service issued in Docket No. 09-ALCT-477-COC,<sup>1</sup> and its CPCN to provide interexchange ("IXC") service issued in Docket No. 09-ALCT-478-COC.<sup>2</sup>

ALEC attests that it is no longer providing any telecommunications services in Kansas, and has no customers in Kansas.<sup>3</sup> Thus, there will be no adverse impact on any consumer in Kansas. In light of the fact that ALEC has ceased telecommunications operations in Kansas, ALEC requests that the Commission cancel all of its authority to provide telecommunications services in Kansas effective immediately.
