# ORDER GRANTING AT&T'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO LATE FILE ENTRY OF APPEARANCE

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On August 14, 2018, the Commission issued an Order Opening Docket; Protective Order Applicable to CURB; Requiring Entries of Appearance to Actively Participate and Establishing Procedural Schedule (hereinafter "Order") in this docket. The Order directed interested parties to file an entry of appearance within fifteen days of the receipt of the Order.

2. On October 10, 2018, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas; AT&T Corp.; Teleport Communications America, LLC; SBC Long Distance, LLC; New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility; and Cricket Wireless, LLC (collectively "AT&T") filed the Motion of AT&T for Leave to Late File Entry of Appearance. AT&T stated it desires to actively participate in this proceeding, but inadvertently missed the filing date for entries of appearance. 3. K.A.R. 82-1-217(b) grants the Commission discretion to allow additional time for good cause shown. The Commission therefore grants AT&T's Motion for Leave to Late File Entry of Appearance.

# IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. AT&T's Motion for Leave to Late File Entry of Appearance is granted.

B. Parties have 15 days, plus three days if service is by mail, from the date of service

of this Order to petition the Commission for reconsideration or request a hearing, as provided in K.S.A. 77-542.<sup>1</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
