NOTICE OF HEARING

On December 26, 2013, the Kansas Highway Patrol issued a Notice of Violation against Custom Limousine, Inc. (Respondent), for alleged violations found during a December 20, 2013, routine motor carrier stop and inspection conducted by the Kansas Highway Patrol. On or about February 17, 2014, the Respondent submitted a request for hearing on this matter, which opened Docket No. 14-GIMM-371-KHP.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-511, the above-referenced matter has been set for hearing. The hearing will be held on June 13, 2014, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as scheduling permits, in the First Floor Hearing Room at the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas, 66604.

The hearing will be formal in nature and will involve both the rules of civil procedure and the rules of evidence. Please note that K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2) requires that corporations appear through an attorney.

Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-229(c), parties will prefile direct testimony ten (10) days prior to the scheduled hearing date. The Commission has authorized the use of electronic filing and service in lieu of the traditional physical filing and service of documents. If electronic filing and service is not utilized, one original and seven copies of the prefiled testimony must be filed with the Executive Director of the Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604. Rebuttal testimony may be presented at the hearing.

If any party(s) fails to appear and participate in this hearing, the Commission may proceed to hear evidence against the party(s) and enter such order as shall be justified by the evidence. Failure to participate may result in default judgment against the Respondent pursuant

to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-520. Further, at any point in the proceedings, a proceeding may be converted into another type of agency proceeding pursuant to K.S.A. 77-506.

Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans With Disabilities Act needs to give notice to the Commission at least ten (10) days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
