PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW MOTION TO COMPEL

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On February 26, 2019, the Commission issued penalty orders against Quito, Inc. (Operator) in these dockets, finding a total of three violations of K.A.R. 82-3-111.¹ On March 20, 2019, Operator filed a request for hearing in both dockets.² The dockets have been joined.³ An evidentiary hearing is scheduled for November 15, 2019.⁴
 - 2. On October 2, 2019, Operator filed a *Motion to Compel*.
 - 3. On October 10, 2019, Operator filed a *Motion to Withdraw Motion to Compel*.
