## **SUSPENSION ORDER**

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds as follows:

- 1. On January 29, 2007, Midwest Energy filed an Application seeking Commission approval to implement a Pay-As-You-Save program for its electric service.
- 2. A full investigation of the Application, which may result in a hearing, is deemed necessary and proper. Staff is without sufficient time to fully review, consider and analyze whether the Application is just and reasonable.
- 3. Suspension of the operation of the proposed Application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117, the operation of the Application shall be suspended and the effective date deferred not more than two hundred and forty (240) days from the date of the Application, January 29, 2007, until September 26, 2007, subject to further order or orders of the Commission.
- B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this Order is by mail, from the date of service of this Order in which to request rehearing on any matter decided herein.

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.
