**MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L” or the “Company”) and requests that the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission” or “KCC”) establish the procedural schedule for this matter. In furtherance thereof, KCP&L requests the Commission schedule an initial prehearing conference as soon as possible. In support of this Motion, KCP&L states:

1. Concurrently with the filing of this Motion, KCP&L has submitted a rate case Application and supporting testimony.

2. KCP&L and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company each filed a rate case before the Missouri Public Service Commission on February 27, 2012. The Missouri rate case schedules are set using an eleven month timeframe. Evidentiary hearings in the KCP&L Missouri proceedings are currently set for October 15 - 26, 2012, and true-up hearings are scheduled for November 15 - 16, 2012. KCP&L has witnesses who are testifying in both the Missouri and Kansas proceedings. In an effort to avoid scheduling conflicts between the two jurisdictions, KCP&L has developed a proposed procedural schedule for consideration in this case that avoids an overlap in evidentiary hearing dates.

3. KCP&L has checked the Commission’s calendar available at the Commission’s website to confirm that there are no existing conflicts with the proposed procedural schedule as outlined below.

4. KCP&L requests that the Commission issue an order as soon as possible scheduling an initial prehearing conference at which the parties can discuss a procedural schedule for this docket and develop an agreed schedule to present to the Commission for approval. KCP&L submits the schedule below for advance consideration by the parties.


5. The Commission establishes procedural schedules under K.S.A. 66-117 for rate case dockets. KCP&L has relied upon schedules in recent rate cases before the Commission in developing the proposed schedule below. Based on the KCP&L Application filing date of April 20, 2012, and accounting for the two-hundred and forty (240) day statutory timeframe under which the Commission must make its determination as specified in K.S.A. 66-117(c), KCP&L proposes the following schedule for consideration:
