ORDER APPROVING NAME CHANGE AND ORDERING REVISED TARIFF

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On August 31, 1999 DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company (DIECA) was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Competitive Local Exchange services within the state of Kansas in Docket No. 99-DCIT-945-COC. DIECA's Certificate of Convenience and Authority was briefly revoked in Docket No. 12-DCIT-332-SHO but was reinstated effective March 21, 2012.
- 2. On March 19, 2012, DIECA filed a letter requesting to change its name to MegaPath Corporation.
- 3. Commission Staff filed its report and recommendation on March 28, 2012, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. Staff found that "MegaPath Corporation" is "active and in good standing" with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office. Staff also found that

DIECA is in compliance with respect to Commission Assessments, Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF), and Annual Report filing requirements. Additionally, Staff noted that DIECA does not receive KUSF support, and, as an IXC, its rates are not regulated by the Commission. Based on this information, Staff recommended that the Commission approve the name change. However, Staff also noted that DIECA did not file a revised tariff reflecting its name change and recommended that DIECA be required to do so.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. The Commission adopts the Commission Staff's recommendations of approving DIECA's name change, and requiring DIECA to file a revised tariff with its new name.
- B. DIECA's request to change its name to MegaPath Corporation is hereby approved.
- C. DIECA is hereby ordered to submit a revised tariff under the new name of MegaPath Corporation within thirty (30) days of this Order. The content of that tariff with respect to services, rates, rules and regulations shall remain unchanged, other than the name change.
- D. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).
- E. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On March 19, 2012, DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company filed a letter requesting to change the Company's name to MegaPath Corporation. Staff recommends Commission approval of this filing.

BACKGROUND:

On August 31, 1999, DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Competitive Local Exchange services within the state of Kansas in Docket No. 99-DCIT-945-COC.

In December 2011, Megapath, Inc., DSLnet Communications LLC, DSLnet Communications VA, Inc., and Covad Communications Company consolidated into DIECA Communications, a wholly owned MegaPath Group subsidiary. DIECA Communications changed its name to MegaPath Corporation in January 2012.

The Commission issued a Show Cause Order 12-DCIT-332-SHO against DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company in February of this year. The Company filed for Reconsideration in March 2012 explaining that administrative issues regarding a relocation had led to the Show Cause and the Commission issued an Order for reinstatement effective 3/21/2012.

ANALYSIS:

With this filing, the Company states that the Reorganization/Consolidation is entirely transparent to Customers, and there is no change to the Company's services, pricing, or terms and conditions of service, per the notice provided to the existing customer base. MegaPath Corporation did not provide a revised tariff with this filing. The new name MegaPath Corporation has been registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office and its status is "active and in good standing." The Company is also in compliance with respect to Commission Assessments, Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF), and Annual Report filing requirements. The Company does not receive KUSF support, and, as a CLEC, its rates are not regulated by the Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Commission approve DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company's request to change its name to MegaPath Corporation. Staff notes that the Company did not file a new tariff, and the current tariff reflects DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company. Therefore, the Company is required to submit a revised tariff under the new name of MegaPath Corporation within 30-days of the date of this Order. The content of that tariff with respect to services, rates, rules and regulations shall remain unchanged, other than the name change.
