ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its pleadings and records, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On May 31, 2024, the Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty ("Liberty") filed an Application to true-up its annual Net Excess Accumulated Deferred Income Tax in Liberty's Tax Change Rider.¹
- 2. On August 21, 2024, Liberty filed a Motion to Withdraw its Application and Cancel its Tax Change Rider.² As detailed in its Motion, Liberty requested to withdraw due to potential tax ramifications from pursuing its Application.³
- 3. Liberty states in its Motion that Commission Staff has indicated support for the request to withdraw the Application and cancel the Tax Change Rider tariff. The Commission also has granted intervention in the matter to the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB").⁴ No party filed an objection or otherwise responded to Liberty's Motion.
