ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 22, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$2,000 for unauthorized injection at the Cummings #W 1 and Walters #2.
2. Operator and Staff have discussed this matter. Operator and Staff have identified a discrepancy in records regarding both wells. This discrepancy has been resolved.
3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the July 22, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


- A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.


