PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Upon his own motion, the Prehearing Officer issues this order.

1. The Prehearing Officer finds that a procedural schedule should be established. At a prehearing conference held on July 15, 2015,¹ all parties agreed to the following schedule:

Applicant's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due by August 3, 2015
Protestant's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due by August 17, 2015
Staff's Pre-filed Rebuttal Testimony	Due by August 24, 2015
Rebuttal Testimony	Due by August 31, 2015
Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission	September 17, 2015, 10:00 a.m.

2. Parties should note the following:
- a. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony will likely result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at hearing.
 - b. At hearing, the Commission may limit direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

¹ The Commission's June 11, 2015, Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference originally scheduled the prehearing conference for June 30, 2015. On June 17, 2015, upon Triple T Oil's uncontested motion, the Prehearing Officer continued the prehearing conference to July 2, 2015.

The protestant, James D. Howell, Jr., failed to attend the July 2, 2015, prehearing conference, apparently due to a procedural misunderstanding. Thereafter, through a series of telephone calls and emails, the parties mutually and informally agreed to reschedule the prehearing conference for July 15, 2015.


- c. Any settlement agreement that the parties wish to present for the Commission's consideration shall be due by August 31, 2015.
- d. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act is asked to give notice to the Commission at least 10 days prior to the scheduled hearing date.


