ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Now, the above-captioned matter comes on before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("KCC" or "Commission") on its own motion. The Commission, being duly advised in the premises and after giving due consideration to the Statutes of Kansas, the regulations of the Commission, and its records and files, makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. The Schaben Mississippi Oil Pool was established by Commission Order dated February 21, 1964 and has been amended on numerous occasions. The original Order and amendments govern well spacing and/or proration and production of oil from the Mississippi formation. The original Order and amendments currently cover the following acreage:

S/2 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 21 West, Ness County, Kansas All of Section 29-31, Township 19 South, Range 21 West, Ness County, Kansas N/2 and SW/4 of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 21 West, Ness County, Kansas S/2 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 22 West, Ness County, Kansas All of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 22 West, Ness County, Kansas All of Section 36, Township 19 South, Range 22 West, Ness County, Kansas All of Section 5-8, Township 20 South, Range 21 West, Ness County, Kansas All of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 22 West, Ness County, Kansas NE/4 and E/2 of SE/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 22 West, Ness County, Kansas

3. The above-referenced field has been identified by Commission staff as a candidate to

have the Basic Proration Order covering the field dissolved due to the depletion of the subject

reservoir and the lack of production from the wells in the field.

4. The Commission is charged with the jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and

gas activities pursuant to K.S.A. 74-623 and to prevent waste pursuant to K.S.A. 55-601 and

K.S.A. 55-701. The Commission has the jurisdiction to institute proceedings for the purpose of

fulfilling said responsibility and to enforce the laws of the State of Kansas.

5. In view of the foregoing, the Commission finds that all parties in interest shall be

directed to appear and show cause as to why the above-referenced Basic Proration Order should

not be dissolved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED: That all parties in

interest be, and the same are, hereby directed to appear before this Commission at 10:00 a.m. or

as soon thereafter as possible, on April 19, 2012, in the Hearing Room of the Conservation

Division, 130 South Market, Room 2078, Wichita, Kansas, 67202-3802, to show cause why said

Basic Proration Order should not be dissolved.

The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties for the purpose

of entering such further order or orders as from time to time it may deem proper.
