D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be

converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as

provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 et seq. Any party

that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this

proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

E. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2), corporations must enter an appearance via an

attorney. If a corporation fails to enter an appearance via an attorney prior to the Prehearing

Conference, it may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.
