## PRE-FILED TESTIMONY OF

- 1 Q. What is your name and business address?
- 2 A. Nancy D. Borst, 266 N. Main St., Suite 220, Wichita, KS 67202
- 3 Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- 4 A. I am employed by the Conservation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission as an
- 5 Administrative Specialist in the Licensing and Legal departments.
- 6 Q. Would you please briefly describe your background and work experience?
- 7 A. I worked as the Communications Coordinator and Public Information Officer for Kingman
- 8 County from 2013 to 2017. Prior to that I was the managing editor of the Kingman Leader-
- 9 Courier newspaper. I have worked in various roles in journalism for the past forty-four years
- and continue to own a freelance journalism business. I have a Bachelor of Science degree
- from the University of Kansas. I have worked for the Kansas Corporation Commission since
- February 2018 as an Administrative Specialist. My primary duties include processing and
- reviewing license applications, processing open records requests, and processing legal filings.
- 14 Q. Have you previously testified before this Commission?
- 15 A. Yes.
- 16 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this matter?
- 17 A. The purpose of my testimony is to discuss the evidence that supports the Commission's
- findings relating to the Penalty Order issued to Haas Petroleum, LLC (Operator) in Docket
- 19 23-CONS-3006-CPEN (Docket 23-3006) for unplugged wells on an expired license.
- Q. Would you please provide a brief background of the facts related to Docket 23-3006?
- A. Operator was penalized for one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-120, because Operator still has
- 22 unplugged wells on its expired license. Operator submitted a license renewal application on
- July 1, 2021. However, Staff did not process that application due to the number of regulatory

- violations found on Operator's leases. On November 22, 2022, the Commission issued a Final
- 2 Order in Docket 22-CONS-3099-CMSC, which denied the license renewal application
- 3 submitted by Operator pursuant to K.S.A. 55-155(c)(4).
- 4 Q. Would you please explain the requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-120?
- 5 A. Yes. K.A.R. 82-3-120 provides that each operator in physical control of any oil, gas, injection,
- or monitoring well or gas storage facility shall maintain a current license even if the well or
- 7 storage facility is shut-in or idle.
- 8 Q. When did Operator's license expire?
- 9 A. Operator's license expired on July 30, 2021.
- 10 Q. Did Commission Staff send a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter to Operator regarding the
- unplugged wells on Operator's expired license?
- 12 A. Yes. On June 22, 2023, Commission Staff sent an NOV letter to Operator requiring Operator
- to address the unplugged wells on its license by July 6, 2023. That letter was attached to the
- Docket 24-3006 Penalty Order as Exhibit A.
- 15 Q. Did you have any communications with Operator regarding the unplugged wells on its
- 16 expired license?
- 17 A. No.
- 18 Q. Are there still unplugged wells on Operator's expired license?
- 19 A. Yes. Operator has transferred some of the wells to other operators, but there are still around
- 20 120 unplugged wells remaining on the license as of the date of this testimony. The supervisor
- of the Environmental Protection and Remediation Department, Kraig Stoll, addresses the
- Request for Change of Operator (T-1) forms in more detail in his testimony.

- 1 Q. Please summarize your recommendation.
- 2 A. I believe the facts in this matter support the Penalty Order assessed by the Commission. I
- 3 would recommend that the penalty assessed against Operator by the Commission be affirmed.
- 4 Operator failed to address the unplugged wells on its expired license by the deadline provided
- 5 in the NOV, or by the deadline set forth in the Penalty Order in this matter. Additionally,
- 6 unplugged wells remain on Operator's expired license.
- 7 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?
- 8 A. Yes.
