ORDER FOR HEARING

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On February 26, 2001, Kansas City Power and Light Company ("KCPL") filed its Application, seeking Commission approval of its proposal for reorganization into a registered holding company structure.

2. On April 30, 2001, a "Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement" ("Stipulation") was filed with the Commission. This Stipulation was signed by representatives of KCPL as well as the other parties to this docket, Commission Staff ("Staff") and the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB"). No other party has sought to intervene and there have been no objections to this Stipulation.

3. Upon the requests of KCPL and Staff, the Commission now establishes a date and time for hearing of Monday, June 25 at 2 p.m., in the First Floor Hearing Room at the Commission, 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas. At the hearing, the parties will have an opportunity to present evidence and make comments regarding the Stipulation, for the Commission to consider as part of their deliberations regarding whether to issue an order approving the Stipulation. A copy of this Order, which shall suffice as notice of the hearing, shall be forthwith provided in-hand to Staff and CURB and mailed to KCPL.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED:

A hearing on KCPL's Application and the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement previously entered by the parties is set for Monday, June 25 at 2 p.m., in the First Floor Hearing Room at the Commission, 1500 S. W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas. Notice of the hearing shall be provided in-hand to Staff and CURB and by first-class U.S. mail to KCPL.

Any party may file a Petition for Reconsideration of this Order within fifteen days of the date this order is served. If service is by mail, service is complete upon mailing and three days may be added to the above time frame.

The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.


