# **ORDER CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND CLOSING DOCKET**

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This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On January 24, 2017, the Commission issued in this docket an Order to Show Cause, Designating a Prehearing Officer, and Setting a Prehearing Conference, which scheduled a Prehearing Conference for February 9, 2017.<sup>1</sup>

2. On February 9, 2017, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a Motion to Cancel [the] Prehearing Conference and Close [the] Docket. Staff's Motion reported that "the well in question has recently been transferred to an active license," and thus, "[s]ince the compliance issue has been resolved, Staff asks that the prehearing conference be cancelled and that the docket be closed."<sup>2</sup>

3. Based on Staff's Motion, the Commission affirms Staff's resolution of the issue concerning Operator's handling of the well in question. The Commission is satisfied with the

B. Parties have 15 days, plus three days if mailed service, from the date this Order

was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.<sup>3</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
