**UPDATE TO TRAFFIC STUDY DATA FOR KUSF REPORTING**

COMES NOW USCOC of Nebraska/Kansas LLC (“U.S. Cellular”), by its counsel, and files this update to its traffic study for the purpose of informing the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”) that Kansas No. 15 Limited Partnership (“Kansas No. 15”) is electing the traffic study methodology and the effective date of that methodology.

1. On May 10, 2011, U.S. Cellular filed its Entry of Appearance and Notice of Use of Traffic Study Data for KUSF Reporting in the above-referenced docket.

2. U.S. Cellular updated its traffic study data on October 21, 2011, which was ultimately approved by the Commission on November 9, 2011.

3. The affidavit filed on May 10, 2011 should have referenced Kansas No. 15 in addition to USCOC of Nebraska/Kansas LLC. The intrastate (and interstate) percentages reflected on the May 10, 2011 affidavit apply to both U.S. Cellular and Kansas No. 15.

4. U.S. Cellular initially filed for use of traffic study data for Kansas Universal Service (“KUSF”) reporting in Docket No. 09-GIMT-272-GIT. The Commission approved U.S. Cellular’s traffic factor by Order in that docket on December

10, 2008, effective November 1, 2008. U.S. Cellular, as well as Kansas No. 15, began using its traffic study on November 1, 2008 to report quarterly revenue to USAC.

5. On February 29, 2012, the undersigned counsel filed a letter notice and attendant affidavit indicating that the traffic study filed by USCOC of Nebraska/Kansas LLC in the above-referenced docket applied to Kansas No. 15 in addition to USCOC of Nebraska/Kansas LLC. The affidavit of John C. Gockley attached to that letter attests to the facts stated therein. The undersigned counsel corrected that letter by letter to the Commission dated March 7, 2012.

6. U.S. Cellular hereby notifies the Commission that the intrastate (and interstate) percentages reflected on the May 10, 2011 affidavit, updated on October 21, 2011, apply to both U.S. Cellular and Kansas No. 15. As approved by the Commission in Docket No. 09-GIMT-272-GIT, U.S. Cellular, as well as Kansas No. 15, began using its traffic study on November 1, 2008 to report quarterly revenue to USAC.

WHEREFORE, U.S. Cellular notifies the Commission that Kansas No. 15 Limited Partnership is electing the traffic study methodology.
