This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Kenneth Bonham d/b/a B&B Wrecker Service (B&B Wrecker Service) for violations of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted July 2, 2024, by a Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 27, 2024. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY: B&B Wrecker Service has been assessed a \$1,250 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$1,250, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of B&B Wrecker Service to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. B&B Wrecker Service must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.\frac{1}{2}

<u>IF YOU FAIL TO ACT:</u> Failure to pay the penalty of \$1,250 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On January 18, 2023, Commission Staff ("Staff") completed a safety compliance investigation of Kenneth Bonham d/b/a B&B Wrecker Service ("B&B Wrecker Service or Carrier") that resulted in the Commission issuing a Penalty Order in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN², in which it levied civil penalties totaling \$750. B&B Wrecker Services is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 2832076. The Commission takes judicial notice of the findings in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN.
- 2. On July 2, 2024, a Staff Special Investigator ("SI") completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of B&B Wrecker Services.
- 3. On July 2, 2024, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation ("R&R"), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$1,250 to be issued to B&B Wrecker Service based on the frequency, timeline and

severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigation, the SI identified five (5) violation(s), accounting for three (3) count(s), of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.³ Staff found two of the same violations that were penalized in the Penalty Order issued to the Carrier in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN and therefore resulted in enhanced penalties.

- 4. Additionally, Staff recommends that B&B Wrecker Service be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.⁴ A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars found the Commission's website can he on at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.
- 5. Staff further recommends B&B Wrecker Service submit a written. comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.⁵
- 6. Finally, Staff recommends that B&B Wrecker Service submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order.⁶ Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112 and 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.
- 8. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.
- 9. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. B&B Wrecker Service is hereby assessed a \$1,250 civil penalty for five (5) violation(s), accounting for three (3) count(s), of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. B&B Wrecker Service is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.

- C. B&B Wrecker Service is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.
- D. B&B Wrecker Service is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.
- E. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of B&B Wrecker Service's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.
- F. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is

in the public interest. For civil penalties of \$500 or less, a corporation may appear by a duly

authorized representative of the corporation.8

If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$1,250 is due G.

in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$1,250 must be made

through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking

Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. You

must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

Failure to pay the \$1,250 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of H.

service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may

result in suspension of B&B Wrecker Service's motor carrier operating authority without further

notice. Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited

to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and

any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

and/or the Revocation of Motor Carrier Authority

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Kenneth Bonham d/b/a B&B Wrecker Service (B&B Wrecker Service) is a motor carrier (MC) possessing public for hire operating authority from the Commission, primarily hauling motor vehicles and liquids/gases. B&B Wrecker Service operates under USDOT 2832076.

On January 18, 2023, Commission Transportation Staff (Transportation Staff or Staff) completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of B&B Wrecker Service that resulted in the Commission issuing a Penalty Order in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN on January 31, 2023, that levied civil penalties totaling \$750. In the current docket, Staff found violations that resulted from non-compliance with the 23-576 Penalty, which will be further outlined below.

On July 2, 2024, a Commission Staff Special Investigator completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of B&B Wrecker Service. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified five (5) violation(s), accounting for three (3) specific count(s), of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carries a penalty according to the FY2025 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$1,250 be issued to the MC.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:

On July 2, 2024, a Commission Staff SI conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of B&B Wrecker Service. The investigation covers a 365 day period and any previous compliance review. Each specific count is detailed below.

Count One (1 of 3)

<u>Juris diction</u>: K.S.A. 66-1,142b, and 49 C.F.R. 392.2, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3h, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

<u>Intent of Law</u>: The MC must comply with the requirements of a Commission Order, including submission of a corrective action plan (CAP) as ordered in a Penalty Order.

<u>Supporting Documentation</u>: B&B Wrecker Service was ordered to submit a CAP in the Penalty Order issued in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN on January 31, 2023. No CAP has been submitted.

<u>Violation</u>: Kenneth Bonham failed to comply with the requirements of a Commission Order, including submission of a corrective action plan (CAP) as ordered in a Penalty Order (Exhibit 1, Page 3). One (1) violation was discovered.

Recommendations: Staff recommends an enhanced fine of \$500, due to the same violation discovered during the January 18, 2023 compliance investigation. The MC was penalized for this same violation in the 23-576 Penalty.

Count Two (2 of 3)

<u>Juris diction</u>: K.S.A. 66-1,142b, and 49 C.F.R. 392.2, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3h, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

<u>Intent of Law</u>: The MC must comply with the requirements of a Commission Order, including attendance at a Commission-sponsored safety seminar as ordered in a Penalty Order.

<u>Supporting Documentation</u>: B&B Wrecker Service was ordered to attend a KCC safety seminar in the Penalty Order issued in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN on January 31, 2023. The MC failed to attend a safety seminar.

<u>Violation</u>: Kenneth Bonham failed to comply with the requirements of a Commission Order, including attendance at a Commission-sponsored safety seminar as ordered in a Penalty Order (**Exhibit 1**, **Page 3**). One (1) violation was discovered.

Recommendations: Staff recommends a fine of \$250.

Count Three (3 of 3)

<u>Juris diction</u>: 49 C.F.R. 391.25, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129. **Intent of Law:** The MC must make an inquiry every 12 months into the annual motor vehicle record (MVR) of its driver.

<u>Supporting Documentation</u>: On April 1, 2024, B&B Wrecker Service permitted its driver and owner, Kenneth Bonham, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 2018 Ram 5500 Tow Truck, VIN ending in 1369, GVWR 19,500 lbs., in intrastate commerce from Burdett, Kansas to Larned, Kansas. This transport is evidenced by a tow

invoice, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, an MVR for Mr. Bonham, dated December 21, 2022, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and a MVR for Mr. Bonham, dated July 1, 2024, attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**. The last MVR for Mr. Bonham was obtained December 21, 2022 and therefore expired on December 21, 2023. A new MVR was not obtained until July 1, 2024, after this transport had occurred.

<u>Violation</u>: B&B Wrecker Service failed to make an inquiry every 12 months into the annual motor vehicle record (MVR) of its drivers (**Exhibit 1**, **Page 3 to 4**). Three (3) violations were discovered. **Recommendations**: Staff recommends an enhanced fine of \$500, due to the same violation discovered during the January 18, 2023 compliance investigation. The MC was penalized for this same violation in the 23-576 Penalty.

RECOMMENDATION:

Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find B&B Wrecker Service committed five (5) violation(s), accounting for three (3) specific counts, of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission. Staff recommends enhanced fines as two (2) of the above counts were deemed to be intentional violations as they were previously discovered and penalized by the Commission in the 23-576 Penalty and for the failure of B&B Wrecker Service to take corrective action to remedy the identified compliance issues. Staff requests the Commission take judicial notice of the findings in Docket No. 23-TRAM-576-PEN.

Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$1,250 for five (5) violation(s) of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends B&B Wrecker Service require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety meetings.htm.

Staff further recommends B&B Wrecker Service submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that B&B Wrecker Service submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.


