EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Westar Energy, Inc. (Westar) and FreeState Electric Cooperative, Inc. (FreeState) are proposing to exchange approximately one-half section of electric territory located in Douglas County. The two electric suppliers have agreed to exchange this territory to better serve the needs of a customer providing service to a water pump. There are currently no existing customers located in the area being exchanged. FreeState is better positioned to provide future electric service in the immediate vicinity of the affected customer.

Staff recommends that the Commission grant these Applications and find that public convenience will be promoted by this transaction.

BACKGROUND:

On May 8, 2017, FreeState filed an Application for a Certificate of Convenience in Docket No. 17-FSEE-491-COC. On May 18, 2017, Westar filed a Companion Application to Cease in Docket No. 17-WSEE-509-CCS.

The Commission has jurisdiction to grant a Certificate to any public utility seeking to transact business in the State of Kansas. K.S.A. 66-1,170 et seq. the Retail Electric Suppliers Act (RESA) requires the State of Kansas to be divided into electric service territories in which only one retail electric supplier is established for a given territory. Notwithstanding the mandated single electric provider service territories, RESA also provides that retail electric suppliers can enter into agreements to amend boundaries between their facilities. The agreements are filed in the form of Certificates and, if approved by the Commission, Certificates to amend territory are issued.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks has requested service for a new flood pump. This is a marginal load and the service location is in a remote area in the flood plain of Clinton Reservoir. The water pump will be used to flood a marsh for duck habitat. The two utilities agree that FreeState is better positioned to serve this area and Wildlife and Parks has applied for electric service from FreeState.

ANALYSIS:

Staff has reviewed the Applications and determined that the legal descriptions and maps provided with the Applications are accurate. Staff has also confirmed that the legal descriptions are not in conflict with the Commission's Certificate records. The proposed revision to the affected territories legal description is included as Attachment 1 to this Report and Recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Commission grant these Applications and find that public convenience will be promoted by this transaction.
